Ride-On

ELECTRIC BIKE SHARING

More than 250 bikes across Dundee, making it the largest in the UK.

Dundee will become the UK headquarters of Ride-On, which is currently based in Madrid and Miami, with an investment of £700,000



Enterprise

POOL CARS

Saving time, money and CO2 by replacing pool car vehicles with a new electric car club fleet.

A new booking system and in-vehicle technology will allow these vehicles to be shared with businesses across the city.



E-Car Club

GREY FLEET

A new all electric car club to drive down the expense and emissions from employees using their own vehicles for work.



Co-Wheels

COMMUNITY MINIBUSES & EASY ACCESS CAR CLUB

New technologies and booking systems to make better use of council minibuses and to give greater flexibility to car club users on where they pick-up and drop-off vehicles.



Just Park

CASHLESS PARKING AND INCENTIVES

Pay-by-phone parking app that encourages people to visit local businesses and provides information on available spaces.



Atkins/ Appy Parking


SMART PARKING
