Dear Executive Committee,

As you will be aware Tactran was awarded grant funding of £649,750 from Transport Scotland for 14 Active Travel Projects in 2023/24 and an [update report](#) was provided at the most recent Partnership Board meeting on 12 September 2023. Two of the projects included in the 14 are being delivered by Perth & Kinross Council – (i) Kinross Park and Ride Sustainable Transport Hub (construction) (£50,000) and (ii) Woodside – Coupar Angus shared use path beside A94 extension (construction) (£100,000).

Perth & Kinross Council officers have recently confirmed that, due to some planning issues, the Kinross P&R project will be delayed into 2024/25 and have requested that 2023/24 £50,000 funding for this project be reallocated to Woodside – Coupar Angus project. The Woodside – Coupar Angus is a multi-year project and increased spending this financial year can be accommodated and would assist in a quicker delivery.

In order to reallocate funding as outlined agreement is required from both Transport Scotland and the Tactran Partnership and we are currently in the process of seeking Transport Scotland's agreement. In order to progress the reallocation of funding as soon as possible, I am seeking Executive Committee approval to reallocate funding as follows:

Current allocation:

Kinross Park and Ride Sustainable Transport Hub (construction) (£50,000)
Woodside – Coupar Angus shared use path beside A94 extension (construction)
(£100,000)

Proposed reallocation:

Woodside – Coupar Angus shared use path beside A94 extension (construction)
(£150,000)

Please note that it is the intention to seek funding to deliver the Kinross P&R project next year.

I would be grateful if you could confirm via e-mail whether you are in agreement with this reallocation by Friday 17th November.
