You will also be responsible for providing support to Partners' processes such as Local Development Planning and Community Planning. This work will involve stakeholder and partner liaison and leading the appraisal, procurement and delivery of proposals and projects.

Ideally educated to degree level in a transportation, or other relevant discipline, you will have experience of transport and wider policy issues within an RTP or local authority environment and have knowledge and/or experience of transportation appraisal and modelling techniques and have knowledge of transport and other relevant legislation and related operational practices and procedures.
